# KC CAN PROCEDURES FOR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

## Pickup Frequency

KC Can Compost will pick up once per week.

## Pickup Location

64-gallon cans will be picked up from the refuse area.

## Pickup Requirements

Customer may use 5-gallon buckets provided or another receptacle to collect organic waste in-house to be emptied into 64-gallon cans to be serviced. Customer will fill 64-gallon cans **no more than 3/4 full and lids will be closed**.

#### Can Return

KC Can Compost will weigh, tip, and return 64-gallon cans to the refuse area.

## **FOOD SCRAPS**

Meat, Poultry, Fish, Shellfish & Bones Eggs & Dairy Products Table Scraps & Plate Scraping Fruits & Vegetables Bread Dough, Pastry, Pasta, Grains Coffee Grounds, Filters & Tea Bags

## **FOOD SOILED PAPER**

Paper Towels, Paper Napkins, and Facial Tissues
Uncoated Paper Take-Out Containers
Pizza Delivery Boxes
Waxed Cardboard & Paper
Uncoated Paper Cups, Plates (no lids, straws or creamers)

## **PLANTS / FLOWER SCRAPS & HAIR**

Plants & Flowers Hair

# **NON COMPOSTABLE ITEMS**

Plastic bags
Plastic wrap
Plastic bottles
Plastic plates
Plastic cups
Plastic utensils
Glass
Metal

Foil

Produce baskets & netting Produce stickers Twist ties Latex or plastic gloves Styrofoam Rubber bands Burlap Grease and liquid

If you are uncertain whether an item is compostable, then place that item in the trash.

If you don't know, don't throw!
